What did you do? Who were you with? Did anything exciting or different happen? Describe the weather!

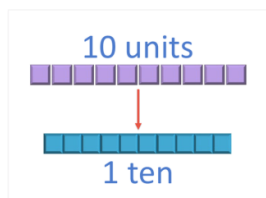
Make an effort to write at least six sentences! Watch out for capital letters, full stops and finger spaces! *Draw a picture of your recount writing too if you would like!*

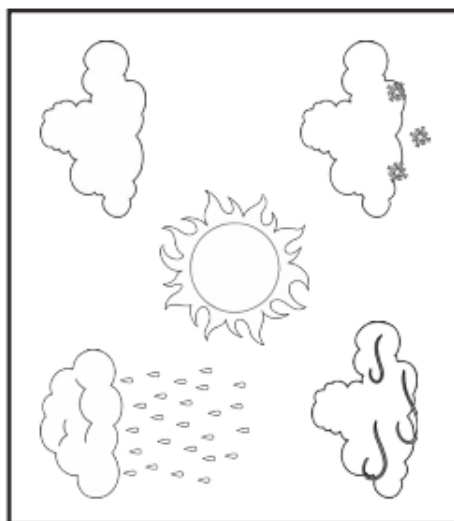

Friendship is very important, especially now more than ever. Think back to our 'friendship recipes' we made at the start of the year. Think of five rules that you think would make a happy friendship.

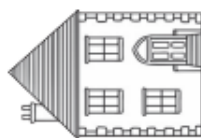
